LOCAL AREA UNEMPLOYMENT STATISTICS PROGRAM

Vermont uses the State Time Series Analysis and Review System (STARS) in calculating its statewide monthly employment and unemployment estimates. Intensive research by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics and the state employment agencies resulted in this variable coefficient regression approach being selected for calculating the state's most prominent economic indicator.

Unemployment and employment statistics for each Labor Market Area and each county are also estimated each month. The Labor Force for an area is defined as the total number of residents of that area who are either currently employed or who are unemployed but ready and available for employment. The unemployment rate is the percent of the total Labor Force that is unemployed.

The statewide unemployment statistics are estimated using input data from the U.S. Bureau of the Census and the Vermont Department of Labor. The Bureau of the Census conducts a monthly survey called the Current Population Survey. The data collected for Vermont residents, along with administrative data from the state's Unemployment Insurance program and estimates from the Current Employment Statistics program, are input into STARS. The STARS regression formulas use current and past data to estimate new regression coefficients to arrive at current unemployment estimates for the state of Vermont.

The Labor Market Area and county estimates are then estimated using a procedure called the LAUS State System (LSS). Various area data, also provided by VDOL, are then used in the LSS to apportion to each area its share of the statewide employment and unemployment estimates. A final adjustment is then made so that the areas add to the statewide total.

This year the estimates for the years 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 have been benchmarked and revised to incorporate the most up-to-date data. The statewide seasonally adjusted unemployment rates have also been revised, with some small changes back to 1976. This year the seasonally adjusted estimates have been developed using a new adjustment method, the Smoothed-Seasonally-Adjusted (SSA) Estimates. SSA estimates are seasonally-adjusted estimates that have incorporated a long-run trend smoothing procedure. This results in estimates that are less volatile than those previously produced by the LAUS estimation methodology. The statewide monthly unemployment rate is seasonally adjusted using factors from the model and published in a separate table. Area estimates are not seasonally adjusted. The unadjusted state data is published in the tables for comparison with the areas.

Statewide estimates are available from January 1976 forward.

Substate estimates are available from January 1990 forward.

Previously published data for Labor Market Areas and Counties are not comparable to the current estimates.

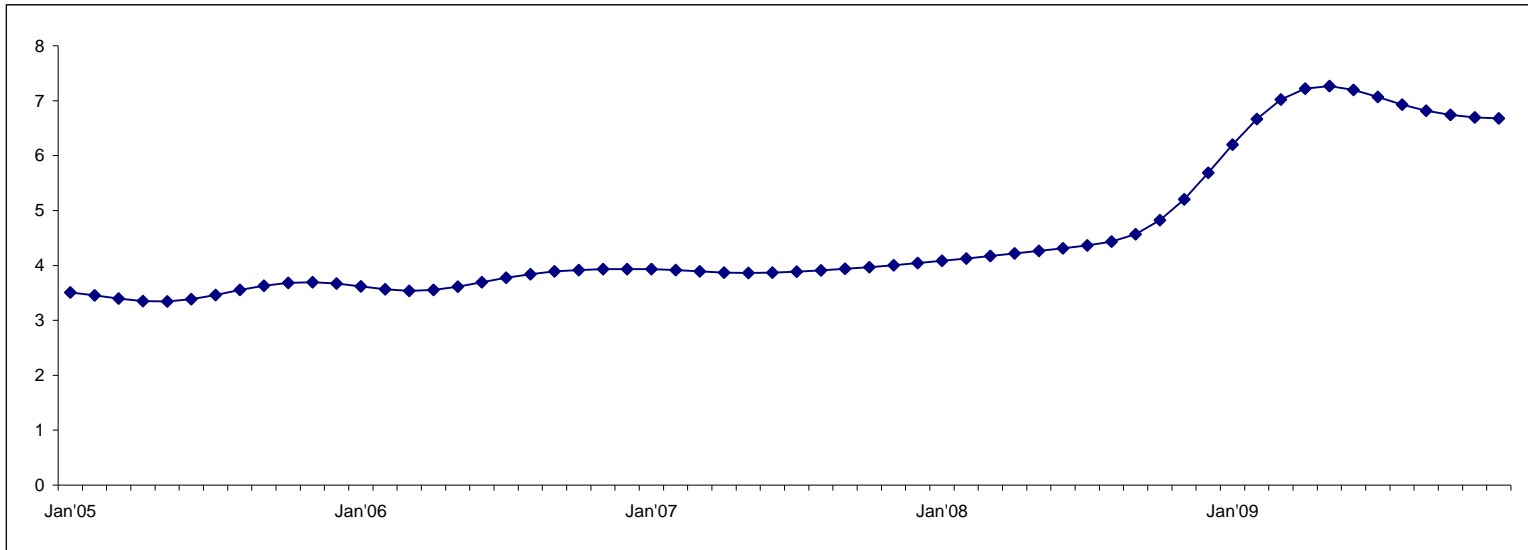
